Theme/Timescale (number of weeks/term etc.)	Theme	National Primary Curriculum 2014 RE coverage
8 Weeks September Autumn 1	New Beginnings	Talk or write about some key teachings in two religions. Use some correct terminology when talking or writing about key beliefs and teachings and recall the details of some stories. Recount some religious stories and recognise some symbols. Recognise and respond to examples of others' values, attitudes and commitments and share their own.
7 weeks November Autumn 2	Beginnings Birth and life of religious leaders	Talk or write about special places, days and objects Identify special books and know some key teachings. Understand the significance of worship, rituals and values for the followers of religions and make comparisons between the religion and beliefs studied.
6 weeks January Spring term 6 Weeks March Spring term	Places of Worship Christianity, Islam, Hindu, Sikh	Identify special places, days and objects. Talk or write about special places, days and objects. Show some understanding of the meaning of stories and symbols. Recount some religious stories and recognise some symbols. Understand the religion of Christians, Hindus Islam and Sikh.
6 weeks May Summer term 7 weeks June Summer term	Journeys/Pilgrims	Talk or write about special places, days and objects. Use some correct terminology when talking or writing about special places, days, rituals and objects and know that different religions can share common features. Understand that symbolic meaning and significance can be expressed in a variety of ways. Respond to others' identity and experiences. Respond to questions about meaning and purpose. Make connections between their own identity and experience and those of others.
