As Scientists we will investigate the different animals.

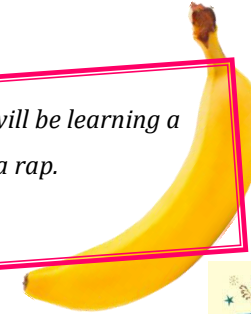

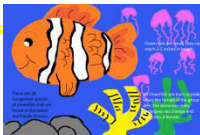


In Design Technology we will create moving pictures.
