Areas of Learning

As Historians we will be studying the lives of significant historical figures such as Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell.



In Geography we will be exploring the different places that Florence visited. We will locate them on a map and compare them.

As Scientists we will learn about animal habitats and what they need to survive in different areas.



We will use cameras in ICT to take pictures of ourselves and we will find out about our bodies using Espresso and Education City. We will then use Textease to select information and word process what we have found out about our bodies.

During PE we will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing, and catching, as well as developing balance, agility, and co-ordination.

In art we will be imitating Andy Warhol by using dots, lines and printing to create Pop Art.

Theme:

Timescale: weeks

Week	Content / Activities
1	History - hook lesson use artefacts to make predictions about Florence Nightingale Geography – knowledge of the 4 countries of the UK and their capital cities. Art – colour wheels of primary colours
2	History – Who was Florence? Geography – naming the continents. Art - colour wheels of secondary colours.
3	History – ordering Florence’s life. Geography – Where did Florence go? – Italy (map, geographical features and comparison to the UK) Art – using the computer to take pictures and turn into line drawings.
4	History – Nursing now and then. Geography – Where did Florence go? – Egypt (map, geographical features and comparison to the UK) Art – colouring
5	History – Who was Edith Cavell? Geography – Where did Florence go? – Turkey (map, geographical features and comparison to the UK) Art – Practising lines and dots
6	History – Who was Edith Cavell? Geography – Compass directions Art – Using lines/dots and colouring to create a pop art image.

7	History – Comparing Florence and Edith. Art – collage and sculpture to create pop art picture.
8	Art - collage and sculpture to create pop art picture.
